Thomas County Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting February 4, 2025

The Thomas County Board of Commissioners convened in open and public session at 8:30 a.m., in the Commissioners meeting room of the Thomas County Courthouse, Thedford, NE. Members present were Pam Moody, Charlie Daly and Lewis Herbaugh. Also present were board secretary/County Clerk Lorissa Hartman, County Treasurer Andrea Thomas, road personnel Doug Heavican and Keith Hartman, Village of Thedford board members Dan Wadas and Kyle Hinton, County Highway Superintendent Lloyd Smith, Dixie Hollenbeck, County Sheriff Joseph Smith and County Attorney Kurt Arganbright.

Chair Moody stated open meeting guidelines are posted as required by law and copies are available, if requested.

Notice of meeting was given by publication in the Thomas County Herald on January 23, 2025.

Motion made by Herbaugh and second by Daly to adopt the February 4, 2025 regular meeting agenda. Roll call vote: Ayes – Daly, Herbaugh, Moody. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Motion made by Herbaugh and second by Daly to approve the January 21, 2025 regular meeting minutes as published in the Thomas County Herald on January 30, 2025. Roll call vote: Ayes- Herbaugh, Daly, Moody. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Road discussion:

Road men reported that the weather was warm enough last week that they were able to do some grading.

The Clerk provided an email that talks about NDOT grants and the portal process. Not sure what projects this grants covers but the board decided to check into projects covered.

Discussion was held on the 2007 Freightliner. Some mechanical issues may be coming up with the truck and the discussion was whether to look into getting rid of it and finding a more suitable truck to replace it with. The discussion was also held on when surplussed if we should use Auction Time or Purple Wave to sell. Commissioner Herbaugh will reach out to the two options and see which company would be the best.

Motion made by Moody and second by Herbaugh to surplus the 2007 Freightliner SN# 1FUJA6CK37LX77260. Roll call vote: Ayes – Daly, Moody, Herbaugh. Nays – none. Motion carried.

During the meeting the board reviewed online the two trucks that were found on the internet, one was located in Elm Creek and the other in St. Edward. The board directed the road men and Commissioner Herbaugh to go check out the trucks.

County Highway Superintendent Lloyd Smith checked with the board about any upcoming armor coat projects for the 2025 season. The two projects discussed were Amsberry Hill section on Windmill Rd and N Seneca Ave. No definite decision made today.

Village of Thedford board members Kyle Hinton and Dan Wadas visited with the board about waste disposal services in the county and the new trash truck costs. The Village discussed increasing waste disposal services by 3%.

Motion made by Daly and second by Moody to approve the Village of Thedford request to increase waste disposal services by 3% for rural residents. Roll call vote: Ayes – Moody, Daly, Herbaugh. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Correspondence presented. Claim for J. Sevier was reviewed; Commissioner Moody will contact for clarification on the charges for mowing and pump work in the auditorium. Mowing of streets/roads throughout the county is the responsibility of the landowner. According to the lease agreement with the Seneca Historical Society all repairs with the Auditorium and property are to be covered by the lessee. The board did agree that the work done for snow removal before the funeral was an acceptable charge. A breakdown of hours for snow removal only needs completed.

Dixie Hollenbeck met with the board to discuss the possibility of issuing a Resolution stating that Thomas County was in opposition to the mandatory use of Electronic ID tags for livestock and requesting that it be a voluntary use instead. Information was provided on various counties that have already issued Resolutions here in Nebraska. County Attorney Kurt Arganbright had advised of Rock County already passing a Resolution in opposition to mandatory use of the tags. The board asked that he share the Resolution with the Clerk and make it an agenda item for the February 18th meeting.
