Thomas County Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting July 15, 2025

The Thomas County Board of Commissioners convened in open and public session at 8:31 a.m., in the Commissioners meeting room of the Thomas County Courthouse, Thedford, NE. Members present were Pam Moody, Charles Daly and Lewis Herbaugh. Also present were board secretary/County Clerk Lorissa Hartman, County Treasurer Andrea Thomas, road personnel Keith Hartman and Doug Heavican, County Sheriff Joseph Smith and County Highway Superintendent Lloyd Smith.

Chair Moody stated open meeting guidelines are posted as required by law and copies are available, if requested.

Road discussion:

Commissioner Daly reported receiving a phone call from Wally Collier about the agreed road material for the past two years for exchange of them taking care of their roads. Suggestion was made to see if Bryan Rodocker would be available to truck the material from Jeffres, Brewster pit down to Collier's. We also have an application on file from Wayne Rodocker for rock on Rodocker Lane, rock to be paid by the landowner and hauled by the county. Commissioner Moody will reach out to Bryan Rodocker to see if he could hall both loads for the county.

The road work along Paxton Ranch Road/Connell Ln was discussed. Clay and gravel need to be hauled in on the portion of road that was built up. This project had been on the 1 & 6 year road plan.

The invitation to bid on the N Seneca Ave armor coat project was reviewed. County Highway Superintendent Lloyd Smith will get it advertised in the Thomas County Herald on July 24^{th} & 31^{st} . The bid opening will be held on August 5^{th} at 11:00 a.m.

The auto gate policy resolution was reviewed. Board suggested language change and suggested to table this until the new road maintenance policy is updated.
